

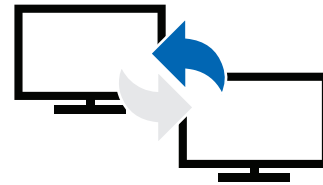

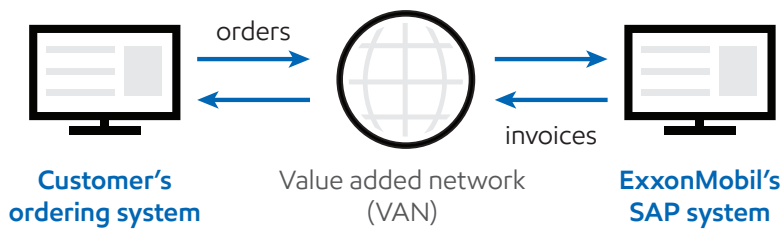

Billions of EDI transactions occur every year as more companies replace regular mail and email to process orders and invoices.

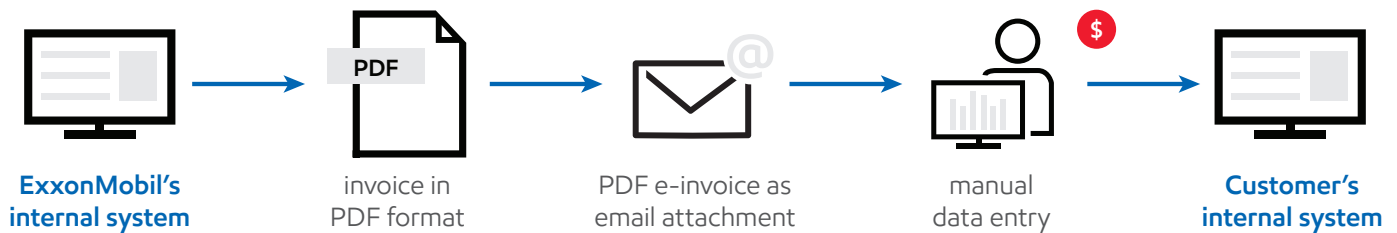
Electronic Data Interchange (EDI) invoices
